



## Rules of the game

The pile of cards is placed in the middle of the table face down. Each player chooses a counter and stands on the START.  
The players roll the dice, the roller with the highest number begins the game.

The first player moves forward according to the number of points on the dice. Next, the player takes the card from the top of the pile and says the sentence with a verb on it.

Depending on the colour of the field, the sentence must be as follows:

- the **red** field - a negative sentence
- the **blue** field - a question
- the **green** field - a positive sentence

The player decides whether to use the Future Simple tense or the Present Continuous tense.

The "key" words help to make a decision.

The player who says the sentence in the wrong tense, misses a turn.

When the player stands on the field with dices - he/she rolls the dice again.

Each player may come across a bad luck or a good luck field and then he/she moves according to the code on the field.

The player who first reaches the FINISH - wins the game.
