

Keep it!

Levels (CEFR)	pre-A1+	
Age	Any	
Time	10 minutes (approx.)	
Materials	Cards (see below)	

Preparation

Make a set of cards for each group of four or five students. On each card, write a question on a topic that students have studied, e.g. (Animals) *Do you have a pet? What's your favorite animal? Which animals live in grasslands?* You could also have students write their own questions or use the sample question cards below.

How to play

- Put students in groups of four or five.
- Hand out the cards and have students place them in a pile face down on the table.
- Students take turns to pick up a card and read out the question.
- They then choose another student to answer the question.
- If a student's answer is appropriate, they win the card.
- The student with the most cards at the end wins.

Note: For lower levels (pre-A1, A1) make picture cards and have students name the picture. If you make two of each picture, they can also play pelmanism and try to find the matching pairs.

Variation

Have **all** the other students answer the question. The student who picked up the card then decides who gave the **best answer** and awards them the card.

Sample cards
