Exercise 3

- Brainstorm food words on the board. Use pictures and photos you have brought and use L1 if necessary. This will save you time answering individual questions later. Begin this activity working with the whole class. Ask students to continue in pairs. Move round, prompting and providing vocabulary.
- To round this activity off, work with the class again. Ask some students what they can remember

about their partner, e.g. Maria loves pizza. She hates fish.

Exercise 4

Give students plenty of time to draw and write.
